VISA TAJIKISTAN AND UZBEKISTAN

A passport with at least 6 months remaining validity is required, together with a Single Entry Tajikistan Visa and a Single Entry Uzbekistan Visa.

TAJIKISTAN VISA

E-VISA

UK passport holders can apply for a Single Entry Tajikistan E-visa via https://www.evisa.tj/index.evisa.html.

The e-visa costs \$50 (Oct 2018) with a \$20 service fee, payable using Mastercard, Visa or American Express, and is valid for a period of up to 45 days with a single entry. Processing may take 2-3 days.

Where asked if you need a **GBAO Permit** – tick **NO**.

Important – when asked your occupation on the application form, do not put anything that might arouse suspicion at the Tajikistan Consulate eg. photographer, writer, journalist, military, government, police etc.

UZBEKISTAN VISA

E-VISA

UK passport holders can apply for a Single Entry Uzbekistan E-visa via www.e-visa.gov.uz

The e-visa costs \$20 (Oct 2018) and is valid for a period of up to 30 days with a single entry. You must visit Uzbekistan within 90 days from the date of issue. Processing may take 2-3 days.

If you require assistance applying for your visa we can recommend using a visa-processing agency such as Travcour www.travcour.com. The Travcour service charge is £30. If you make it clear on your application that you are travelling with KE, you will obtain a £2.50 discount off the service charge. You will need to supply 1 passport photograph and a copy of your passport.

Other nationalities

Please note that some nationalities will require a letter of invitation and a visa support letter. Our ground agent in Uzbekistan can provide a letter of invitation on request, but this requires us to apply to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Uzbekistan. This process can take around 2 weeks and in 2017 there was a charge of US\$30 (or equivalent) for the support letter. Please check with your local embassy to see whether a letter of invitation is required.
