

VISA PAKISTAN for K2 and GHU trips

All nationalities need a passport with at least 6 months validity at the time of travel and a visa for entry into Pakistan.

UK PASSPORT HOLDERS SHOULD APPLY ONLINE FOR THEIR PAKISTAN VISA

The online visa application process makes it possible to obtain both your entry visa and trek permit. Please note that the process described below is for our K2 and GHU trips only.

We recommend using the browser **Google Chrome** to make your application.

Apply online at <https://visa.nadra.gov.pk/mountaineering-trekking/> using the guidelines that you find there.

Documents required by the Pakistan authority to be uploaded during your online visa application

- List of members who are accompanying you on your trek (provided by KE)
- Sponsor letter/Agreement from designated tour operator (provided by KE)
- Trekking Application Form
- Digital scan of the biometric page of your valid passport
- Digital passport-style photograph (see Visa website for exact requirements)
- You MAY be asked to provide 3 months' bank statements and/or proof of address (e.g. utility bill)

Your visa will be emailed to you as a 'Visa Grant Notice'. Please send a copy of this to the KE office.
