VISA PAKISTAN for K2 and GHU trips

All nationalities need a passport with at least 6 months remaining validity at the time of travel and a visa for entry into Pakistan.

WE NOW RECOMMEND ALL UK PASSPORT HOLDERS TO USE THE PAKISTAN e-VISA ONLINE APPLICATION

The e-Visa application process makes it possible to obtain an entry visa and trek permit in one online process. Please note that the process described below is for our K2 and GHU trips only.

We recommend using the browser Google Chrome to make your application.

Documents required by the Pakistan authority to be uploaded during e-visa application

- List of members who are accompanying you on your trek (provided by KE)
- Sponsor letter/Agreement from designated tour operator (provided by KE)
- Trekking Application Form
- Digital scan of the biometric page of your valid passport
- Digital passport-style photograph (see e-Visa website for exact requirements)
- You MAY be asked to provide 3 months' bank statements and/or proof of address (e.g. utility bill)
