

VISA PAKISTAN for Nanga Parbat (NPA)

All nationalities need a passport with at least 6 months validity at the time of travel and a visa for entry into Pakistan.

UK PASSPORT HOLDERS SHOULD APPLY ONLINE FOR THEIR PAKISTAN VISA

THE VISA IS GRANTED FOR A PERIOD OF 90 DAYS FROM YOUR APPLICATION AND WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU APPLY FOUR TO SIX WEEKS BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL IN PAKISTAN

The online application process is relatively simple. The process described here is for Nanga Parbat (NPA) only.

We recommend using the browser **Google Chrome** to make your application.

Apply online at <https://visa.nadra.gov.pk/tourist-visa/> using the guidelines that you find there.

Documents required by the Pakistan authority to be uploaded during the application.

- Sponsor letter/Agreement from designated Pakistani Tour Operator (provided by KE)
- Pakistani Tour Operator Licence (provided by KE)
- Pakistani Tour Operator National Identity Card (NIC) (provided by KE)
- Proof of Islamabad hotel booking (provided by KE)
- Digital scan of the biometric page of your valid passport
- Digital passport-style photograph (see - Visa website for exact requirements)
- You MAY be asked to provide 3 months' bank statements and/or proof of address (e.g. utility bill)

Your visa will be emailed to you as a 'Visa Grant Notice'. Please send a copy of this to the KE office.
